



The Administration and staff of St. Patrick School believe that good grooming and proper attire foster a positive self-image and an environment conducive to learning. All students are expected to present a neat, clean and modest appearance with clothing that is appropriate in size and fit. In all cases, the administration reserves the right of final determination concerning proper student attire. Enforcement will be handled by the administration and staff. With that in mind, the following Uniform Policy is in effect for all students at St. Patrick School.

Boys Uniform 2020-2021

Uniform	Rules for Wear
Slacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-8 wear khaki or navy blue dress slacks with front zipper and belt loops. Must be a Docker-type, dress twill style. Plain-front or pleated-front slacks are acceptable. Uniform shorts may be worn in the first and fourth quarters of school. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn at the waist. Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt. (Grades 1-8) Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed. Not permitted: jean-style, flares, slacks with rivets, and slacks with exterior pockets (i.e. cargo pants). Not permitted: cargo shorts.
Shirts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-5 wear a solid light blue or navy polo-style shirt (cotton or dry-wicking) with the "St. Patrick" name embroidered on left chest. Grades 6-8 wear a solid hunter green polo-style shirt (cotton or dry-wicking) with the "St. Patrick" name embroidered on left chest. Grades 6-8 wear a solid white Oxford cloth shirt on Mass days, along with the school issued or hunter green tie. Oxford cloth shirts must button down the front, have a button-down collar and may be long or short sleeved. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirt must be tucked into the slacks with the waistband visible. Only the top button of the shirt may be unbuttoned. Solid white, short sleeved t-shirt or undershirt may be worn underneath uniform shirt. Undershirt sleeves should not extend beyond the sleeve of the uniform shirt. Not permitted: turtle-necks.
Sweaters: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-8 may wear a solid navy or hunter green sweater. Cardigans, vests, crewneck and v-neck pullover styles are acceptable. Students in grades K-8 may wear a quarter zip fleece, with the Celtic cross logo. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An oxford cloth shirt or polo-style shirt must be worn under the sweater. Sweaters must have the Celtic cross logo. Not permitted: hooded, striped, or multi-colored design sweaters. Grade 8 may wear their class jacket.
Socks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-8 wear solid white, navy, black or hunter green socks. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Socks must be worn and visible at all times. Only one pair of socks may be worn at a time.
Shoes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> MUST be one or two solid neutral colors, such as: black, brown, beige, gray or navy. This includes laces and logos. Shoes must be closed at the toe and heel. Shoes should tie, Velcro, or be loafer style. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shoes with laces should be tied. Not acceptable: brightly colored, neon or light-up shoes, basketball or high-top shoes, shoes with built-in wheels. Boots are to be worn to-and from school or at recess only.

Girls Uniform 2020-2021

Uniform	Rules for Wear
Jumpers, Skirts and Skorts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-8 wear the St. Patrick plaid uniform skirt or solid navy skirt. Grades K-5 may wear plaid jumper or skort. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jumper length and skirt length is to be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the kneecap. Skirts cannot be rolled and must be worn at the waist. The waistband must be visible. Bike shorts, tights or navy leggings must be worn underneath. Pants under the jumper or skirt may be worn to-and from school or at recess only. Skirt needs to sit comfortably on waist and hips; pleats lay flat and pockets do not gap.
Slacks and Shorts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-8 wear navy blue dress slacks with front zipper and belt loops. Must be a Docker, or dress twill style. Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable. Uniform shorts may be worn in the first and fourth quarters of school (appropriate length-see skirt rules). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn at the waist. Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt. Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed. Not permitted: low rise or dropped-hip slacks, capri-style, jean-style, flares, slacks with rivets, and slacks with exterior pockets (i.e. cargo pants).
Blouses/Shirts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades K-5 wear a solid light blue or navy polo-style shirt (cotton or dry-wicking) or a light blue Peter Pan collar blouse with the "St. Patrick" name embroidered on left chest. Grades 6-8 wear a solid hunter green polo-style shirt (cotton or dry-wicking) with the "St. Patrick" name embroidered on left chest or a white oxford style shirt (no logo required). Blouses and/or shirts may be long or short sleeved. Grades 6-8 will wear a white Oxford cloth blouse without a logo on Mass days. The Oxford blouse must have a button-down collar. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted: turtle-necks, shirts with ornamentation. Only the top button of the shirt may be unbuttoned. Shirt must be tucked into slacks or skirt with the waistband visible. Solid white, short sleeved t-shirt or undershirt may be worn underneath uniform shirt. Undershirt sleeves should not extend beyond the sleeve of the uniform shirt.

Sweaters: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades K-8 may wear a solid navy, or hunter green sweater. • Plain cardigans, vests, crewneck and v-neck pullover styles are acceptable. • Grades K-8 may wear a quarter zip fleece. This fleece must have the Celtic cross logo embroidered on left chest. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweaters must have the Celtic cross logo. • A blouse, polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweater. • Not permitted: ruffled, hooded, striped, floral, and multi-colored design sweaters. • Grade 8 may wear their class jacket.
Socks/Tights: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades K-8 wear solid white, hunter green or navy ankle or knee socks. • Solid white or navy tights or navy leggings are permitted. A solid cable-knit pattern for tights is acceptable. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Socks must be worn and visible at all times. • Not permitted: Lacy or frilled socks or tights.
Shoes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MUST be one or two solid neutral colors, such as: black, brown, beige, gray, white or navy. This includes laces and logos. • Shoes must be closed at the toe and heel. • Shoes should tie, Velcro, or be loafer style. • For gym shoes, see Physical Education section. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with laces should be tied. • Boots are to be worn to-and from school or at recess only. • Not permitted: Shoes with sequins, sparkles, or accent colors or prints, shoes with heels over one inch, platforms, sandals, clogs, moccasins or shoes with built-in wheels.
For all Students	Rules for Wear
Physical Education: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades K-8: Cotton or dry-wicking navy gym t-shirt with Celtic cross logo. • Grades K-8: Hunter green mesh sports shorts without logo. • Grades K-8: Optional: Navy sweatpants with Celtic logo, track style green pants and/or green jacket with Celtic logo. • Tennis shoes and socks are required for PE. • Tennis shoes and socks are required for PE. 	<p>Gym shoes must be worn ONLY in P.E. class. An extra pair of tennis shoes MUST be kept in school. Students in Grade 5-8 must change into a school uniform shirt after gym class. Uniform or green track pants must be worn the rest of the school day.</p>
Jewelry: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A simple cross or religious medal with chain is permitted. • One bracelet or simple wrist watch may be worn. • One pair of small earrings (studs only) may be worn. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earrings must be worn on earlobe. No hoop or dangling earrings. • Boys may not wear earrings. • All accessories should be free of ornamentation.
Hair and Make-Up: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair must be a natural color and always neat and clean. • Bows, scrunchies, and barrettes must be solid white, navy, hunter green, or uniform plaid with no logo or embellishments. • Sport headbands may be worn but must be a solid color. Navy, hunter green, white or black are acceptable. • Make-up is not allowed. • Girls may wear only clear nail polish. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hairstyle and make-up are not to be a distraction. • Boys' hair is to be above the ears, eyebrows and collar. • Bows should not be a distraction; Jo Jo type bows are not part of the uniform. Bows should be 6 inches or smaller. • No glitter in hair, no excessive fad haircuts or styles.
Dress-up Day: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys: Dress pants and collared shirts. • Girls: Dresses and skirts of appropriate length (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) or dress pants. Dresses may not be strapless. Shoulders must be covered. • Uniform may always be worn on Dress-up days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not permitted: jeans, tennis shoes, flip-flops, shorts, tight or revealing attire. • Suggested attire for girls: dresses, skirts, dress pants and dress shoes. • Suggested attire for boys: collared polo-style shirt, dress shirt, tie, dress pants and dress shoes.
Casual Day: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate non-uniform dress is to be worn. • Shirts must cover the shoulder and go down to the hips with an appropriate neck line. • Not permitted: Tank tops, torn clothes, inappropriate t-shirts, skin-tight or low-rise pants, logos on the seat of pants, tight or revealing attire, clothing that promotes media or actions contrary to St. Patrick School policies. • Yoga pants, leggings or skinny jeans may ONLY be worn if a shirt, dress or skirt (of appropriate length-past mid-thigh) is worn over them. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents should carefully review shirts and pants with mottos, graphics and advertisements. • Pants must be worn at the waist. • Shorts or skirts, when permitted, must be no shorter than mid-thigh length. • Socks must be worn at all times. Crocs and flip-flops are not permitted.
Uniform Spirit Day Attire: Students remain in uniform attire except they may wear a St. Patrick T-shirt or jersey.	
Casual Spirit Day Attire: Following the rules for a casual day, except students must wear St. Patrick gear.	
Sports, Scouts and Clubs Cheerleading uniforms and St. Patrick team jerseys may be worn on the Friday before a home game. Standard scouting uniforms may be worn on meeting days. Student Council members may wear Student Council t-shirts on meeting days.	<p>No casual scouting uniforms, such as jogging sets, sweatshirts etc are considered acceptable.</p>
